Hope – confident expectation in the Lord

Matthew 12:18-21

I. Jesus takes <u>Our Place</u>. (Matthew 27:11-26)

Isaiah 53:7

~"We have to renounce our lordship and submit to Jesus' Lordship"

II. Jesus <u>Endures</u> as King for His People. (Matthew 27:27-44)

Acts 4:27; Romans 3:10-12; Romans 3:23

~"We have to understand the crucifixion was done by us before we can understand the crucifixion was done for us."

Galatians 3:13; 5:11; Hebrews 12:2

III. Jesus <u>Willingly</u> Dies to Give Life. (Matthew 27:45-51)

Psalm 22:1, 7-8, 14-18

Hebrews 6:19-20; 10:19-22

So, what is our hope?

1. We have the hope that our sins are <u>atoned for</u>. (1 John 2:2)

2. We have hope that we are <u>right</u> before God. (2 Corinthians 5:21)

3. We have hope to share not only that Jesus died on the cross, but <u>why he died</u> on the cross.
